All cabins are per person double occupancy. The taxes for the cruise are the same for all categories and are as follows: \$265.28 per person. We need names and 500.00 per cabin to reserve the accessible staterooms. Initial deposits, to keep the guarantee of staterooms we blocked is \$1500.00, which is due by March 14, 2010. Full deposits are due (for non accessible staterooms) August 1, 2010 and final payment is due by October 15, 2010.
